CLASSES

Class 1: 50cms - Individuals and Teams. Open to Pony Club members, 12yrs and under, who may be assisted but not lead – see rules for full details.

Class 2: 60cms - Individuals and Teams. Open to Pony Club members, 14yrs and under

Class 3: 70cms - Individuals and Teams. Open to Pony Club members only

Class 4: 80cms - Individuals and Teams. Open to Pony Club members only

Class 5: 90cms – Individuals and Teams. Open to Pony Club members only

The classes will be run as **Single Phase**, see rules below for definition.

All classes will run in accordance with The Pony Club Show Jumping 2024 Rule Book.

ENTRY FEES

£15 per individual.

Entries will be limited and will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

RULES

- The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to prevent and avoid accidents occurring and must obey all instructions given by organisers, stewards, officials or written notices.
- The organisers will not accept any responsibility or liability for any accident, damage, loss, injury or illness however caused except where they are liable by law.
- Hard Hats must be worn with the chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must be Pony Club Approved and Tagged with a current Pony Club hat tag.
- Organiser's reserve the right to amend any classes according to the number of entries.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry made by any person, if they so shall deem it right to do so, without giving any reason.
- The Judge's decision shall be final at all times.
- If we are unable to run the event, refunds will be issued minus an admin fee.
- All classes will run under the Pony Club Rules for 2024.
- Working in for all classes, must be by a competitor with a class entry on that pony.
- No more than two classes per rider/horse combination.
- Single Phase Definition - The first 7 fences will not be against the clock but will have a time allowed. Unless eliminated, you must continue straight on to the next 5 fences without a bell being rung. These fences will be higher than the first half and will be against the clock. Competitors are placed on total faults over the whole course and their time in second half.
- Class 1 – members may be assisted, meaning that one person can stand in the arena while that member competes, to encourage them around the course. No physical contact to be made with the member and/or horse or pony.
- By entering, you agree to our terms and conditions. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- Horses/Ponies must not be left tied to lorries/trailers and left unattended
- Please make sure all droppings etc are removed from around your vehicle before departing
- **NO MUCKING OUT INTO THE LORRY PARK PLEASE**
- Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times and are not permitted in the office area of the main building. Owners are requested to pick up & dispose safely of any mess left by their dogs.
