FUN SHOW DAY FOR ALL AGES on Sunday 7th April 2024

To be held at Pauls Farm, Dunkirk Lane, Leyland, PR26 7SY. Bring a picnic lunch. There will be a selection of homemade cakes to purchase on the day. Approx start 10am. Approximate class times to be posted after the close of entries. In support of Olivia Stubbs' fundraising efforts for the PCIA tour to Kentucky.

TACK AND TURNOUT for pony and rider. All riders will be checked for turnout when the tack is checked in the warmup area. Up to 5 points will be given to all riders who are correctly turned out as per the Pony Club rulebooks.

EQUITATION (Enter 1 class corresponding to rider age)

Riders will be asked to walk and trot around as a group followed by performing a short show incorporating a walk and trot on each rein, a canter if appropriate finishing with a halt and salute.

Class 1: 8 Years and under

Class 2: 9 and 10 years

Class 3: 11 and 12 years

Class 4: Any age

SHOW JUMPING (Enter a maximum of 2 classes, Judged on style and performance)

Class 5: Poles on the floor (Rider any age)

Class 6: Jumps 30cm (Rider any age)

Class 7: Jumps 45cm (Rider any age)

Class 8: Jumps 60cm (Rider any age)

Class 9: Jumps 75cm (Rider any age)

HANDY PONY (Enter 1 class corresponding to rider age)

Class 10: 8 Years and under

Class 11: 9 and 10 years

Class 12: 11 and 12 years

Class 13: Any age

MOUNTED GAMES (Enter 1 class corresponding to rider age)

(Bending, Mugs, Walk, Trot, Lead, Egg & Spoon)

Class 14: 8 Years and under

Class 15: 9 and 10 years

Class 16: 11 and 12 years

Class 17: Any age

FANCY DRESS: (Enter 1 class corresponding to rider age)

Class 18: 12 years & under

Class 19: Any age

RULES

1. The 8 years and under classes will be divided with a lead rein section if entries warrant. PLEASE state on the entry form if lead rein.
2. Riders competing on the lead rein must do so in all classes entered with no exception.
3. Whips must not be carried in Handy Pony or Mounted Games classes.
4. Points can be gained by one pony/rider combination.
5. Riders can do 2 jumping classes, they will gain points in only ONE jumping class, the class in which they were placed higher.
6. Points will be awarded to the first 6 in each class, except for fancy dress.
7. Prizes and rosettes will be awarded in each class and age group
8. Age as on 1-1-2024

£35.00 for 4 classes entered by one pony/rider combination.
