Awards	Class 1 is non-competitive. Rosettes for all competitors. Class 2 rosettes to 6 th place, and rosettes for all competitors not placed but completing all phases. Classes 3 to 5 rosettes to 6 th place and Best Dressage in each section The organisers reserve the right to increase/decrease the number of rosettes awarded in ratio to the entries per section. Award for highest placed NWPC member in each section.	
Directions	The event will be signposted from Leamington Road, Long Itchington and the Offchurch/Long Itchington junction from the Fosseway. We advise lorries exceeding 7.5 tonnes to approach from the Fosseway direction.	
Numbers & Bibs	Every rider will be required to PRINT THEIR OWN NUMBER and use a BE style number bib. Please bring your own. Bridle/saddle cloth numbers are permitted for the dressage, however there must be one on each side of the pony.	

CONDITIONS

1. **Entries close on Sunday 1st September** - no refund for withdrawal after this date unless accompanied by a vet's or doctor's certificate – then a refund will be made less £5 administration costs. Entries may be limited, and a waiting list will be kept.
2. The course will be available to walk from 2pm on Saturday 14th September.
3. The Event will run strictly under **Pony Club Rules for Eventing 2024 – PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ARE FAMILIAR WITH THESE**. Any variation to these will be posted at the Secretary's tent on the day. **A JOCKEY SKULL CAP, WITH NO FIXED PEAK, should be worn FOR THE CROSS COUNTRY PHASE. Body Protectors must meet BETA 2018 level 3 standard (Blue/Black label)**
4. This event is aimed at young or inexperienced competitors.
 - a. The cross country phase will take place within one field and will not be timed.
 - b. Dressage tests may be commanded and any normal riding bit will be permitted.
 - c. A Pony Club coach will be available on the day to assist any child on the XC who may be experiencing problems. Please state at the collecting ring if you would NOT like assistance.
 - d. **Assisted means hands on assistance.**
 - e. **Verbal assistance is permitted in Class 3b, any hands on assistance given in class 3b will result in the competitor being moved into the Assisted section 3a.**
5. **Legal Liability** - Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
6. **Health & Safety:** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
7. The decision of the Chief Steward will be final and binding.
8. Any objection must be made in writing and lodged with the Secretary within 15 minutes of the results being posted, with a £25 deposit, which will be refundable if the objection is upheld.
9. By entering this competition I authorise photographs/videos/other images of my son/daughter taken by the press/outside agencies/official Pony Club photographers at this official Pony Club event to be published in the press and on the internet for publicity purposes. I understand that The Pony Club will select photographs for publication with care and respect. You have the right to opt out. Please indicate on the entry form if you do not wish photographs to be used.
