Entries should be made by your Dressage Team Manager and with the approval of the District Commissioner of your Pony Club Branch.

**Class 1** £25 including paramedic fee

**Booking fees** are payable direct to Horse Events when placing your entry and are nonrefundable and on a per class basis.

## PRIZES

Additional prizes may also be presented at the Presentation Ceremony following each class. Please encourage all competitors to attend prize giving IN CORRECT RIDING DRESS. Times of the Presentations will be updated on **Pony Club Results** throughout the day.

## PROTESTS AND OBJECTIONS

Apart from the Official Steward, the Area Representative and officials of the competition, only District Commissioners or their Appointed Representatives are entitled to lodge protests or objections, which must be made in writing and addressed to the Organiser of the Area Competition, or Secretary of the Championships. They must be accompanied by a deposit of £50 at either Area or Championships, which is forfeited unless the Jury of Appeal decides that there were good and reasonable grounds for them.

Protests or objections must be made not later than half an hour after the scores have been published. The Official Steward/Organiser shall give their decision in the first instance. If this is not accepted, the Jury of Appeal shall give their decision after investigation and this decision is final.

## **WINTER LEAGUE DRESSAGE**

Presentations to the winners will be made during the luncheon interval. Again, timing will be indicated on Pony Club Results.

## **DRESSAGE INSTRUCTIONS**

Times will be available from Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2026 after 19.00 hrs on **Pony Club Results**.

**RESPONSIBILIY FOR CORRECT TACK AND DRESS** remains the responsibility of the Member and DC. There will be a **SAFETY** Tack and Turnout inspection for each competitor before they compete.

**REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer.

Adjustments are any reasonable actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty.

In order for such requests to be accommodated, any requests for reasonable adjustment must be made by Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> June, by e-mail to: Anne Sandford, aesandford@yahoo.co.uk.

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. **Legal Liability:** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. **Health & Safety:** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards
3. **Reasonable Adjustment:** Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026.
4. **Rules:** The event will be run under Pony Club Dressage Rules 2026 and it is the responsibility of the competitors to make sure that they understand and adhere to the rules.
5. **Vaccination:** The event venue stipulates all horses/ponies entering the event site must comply with 2026 Pony Club vaccination rules - passports must accompany all horses/ponies and spot checks may be undertaken
6. **Hat- Tagging:** Please ensure that the riding hat is tagged in line with the Pony Club rules - pink tags. Yellow hat tags are required if wearing spurs.
7. **Reservation of Rights:** The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class/ amalgamate sections where there are insufficient entries or split classes if oversubscribed

and reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of the whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse/pony in poor lame condition, and to refuse any entry for any reason at their sole discretion.

8. **Withdrawal and Abandonment:** The event will follow 2026 Withdrawal and Abandonment criteria – Pony Club Dressage Rulebook 2026, page 11. If a Member, Branch or Centre withdraws a team or individual prior to the closing date for a competition, a full refund of entry will be made, less an administration charge of £5. Withdrawals after the closing date for a competition will not be refunded. In the event of a competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be given.
9. **Tests:** Copies of dressage tests may be downloaded from the Pony Club website. The Prix Caprilli test is downloadable from the Area 12 website.
10. **Time & Results:** Please refer to **Pony Club Results** for times and results.
11. **Lunging:** No Lunging will be allowed on the day.
