

CAMP CHECK LIST

6th August not before 4.00pm (details will follow) - 11th August

Try to exercise your pony most days before camp so that you will both be fit and enjoy camp even more. Make sure that your horse's shoes are not hanging off!! Not always easy to get a Farrier.

BRING for YOUR PONY

Enough hard food for the number of days staying (2 feeds per day).

Haynets, 2 Water buckets, Feed bowl

Mucking out equipment, skip/fork/shovel/broom/wheelbarrow

Grooming kit

Tack cleaning equipment

Spare numnahs (if used)

Headcollar and rope

String for tying up

BRING for ALL RIDERS (Sleeping arrangements: Horse trailer/box, tent or caravan

2 large towels

Bedding (sleeping bag/pillow or blankets) please bear in mind that the night can be very chilly indeed so please make sure you have sufficient bedding/warm clothing for nights.

Drinks bottle (labelled)

Toilet bag

Jeans (2 pairs) shorts

Trainers and pumps`

Wellingtons and waterproofs

Extra pairs of jodhpurs

Extra shirts/polo shirts for riding

Anorak

Underwear and socks

Body protector (must be BETA 2018 level 3 (blue and black label)

Hat (must be to PAS 015(2011) or equivalent standard and tagged by PC)

Torch

Pocket money (£5)

Tack (when you bring your pony)

Copy of Manual of Horsemanship (not essential but recommended)

Horse/Pony's passport

HEALTH AND SAFETY ISSUES:

LORRIES – if lorry is staying on site and being used for overnight accommodation it must be parked 6 metres from the next one (fire safety)

NO CALOR GAS in lorries or caravans.

NO DOGS AT ANY TIME by request of Owner

NO BIKES are permitted on stable lines and when not in use to be stood up. Any found lying about, will be withheld until the end of Camp.

NO ALCOHOL on site.

NON PONY CLUB MEMBERS must be supervised at all times and are NOT covered by Pony Club Insurance.

ALSO:

- Everyone must bring a cake in a tin named for return
- A signed form re medication and permission etc.
- Balance owing for cost of Camp to be submitted to Alison Vincent *no later than 1st August 2024. Members will not be allowed into Camp until full payment is received.*
