**Class 1**

Open for Team and Individual Jumping — This class is for beginners

Fences—all cross poles (Riders can be lead)

**Class 2**

Open for Team and Individual Jumping—This class is also for beginners.

Fences—approx. 30cm (Riders can be lead)

**Class 3**

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age

Fences approx 40cm (Can be assisted but not lead)



All riders in Classes 1– 3 will receive an Easter Egg if they complete their round

**Any pony/rider combination entering Classes 1 and/or 2 cannot enter Classes 4–7**

**Class 4**

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age

Fences 50 cm with some fences 55cm in the jump off section

**Class 5**

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age

Fences 60-cm with some fences 65cm in the jump off section

**Class 6**

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age

Fences 70cm with some fences 75cm in the jump off section

**Class 7**

Open Team and Individual Jumping— Riders any age

Fences 80cm with some fences 85cm in the jump off section

**Class 8**

Open Team and Individual Jumping—Riders any age.

Fences 90cm with some fences 95cm in the jump off section

All classes, will be run as single-phase.

**Entry fee—£15 per rider per class**

Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place for individual and 4th place for teams. Teams to consist of 3 or 4 riders with the best 3 scores of each team to count .

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

- Ages as at 1st January 2026
- All classes as per Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026
- Riding hats must conform to Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026  
Hats must be worn correctly fastened, at all times, while mounted.  
All jewellery must be removed. Suitable footwear must be worn.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or amend the order of classes or cancel classes
- Any objections to be notified to the Secretary within half an hour of the incident with a deposit of £10 -non-refundable if over-ruled by the Chief Steward
- The decision of the organisers is final
- Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
